examining the pedagogical aspects of social protest as the main resource for consciousness raising among historically marginalized youth and adults *caffie greene* and black women activists asks the essential question what can we learn about grassroots community organizing that we do not yet know by centering a black woman like *caffie greene* s life what are the continuities in *greene* s political work between cold war radicalism black power and black feminism and that strict binaries like integrationist and black separatist nationalism and socialism and feminism and black power obscure this book will be of key interest to students and scholars studying black activist history black feminism and twentieth century united states history
